Basic Barbecue rules:

- All general HTC rules apply while staying on the High Tech Campus Eindhoven
- The barbecue places shown on the site map below are the only locations that can be used for barbeque purposes
- Place the barbecue at least 10 meters from the campus buildings
- Place the barbecue on a steady surface
- Choose you place wisely. Do not move a burning barbecue
- Be careful near bushes and trees, furniture, sunscreens etc.
- Keep a bucket of water nearby (or suitable fire extinguisher, not from a HTC building)
- Be aware of the wind blowing smoke towards a HTC building (triggering smoke alarms)
- Charcoal barbecue: be careful with flammable liquids, Gas barbecue: check the gas regulator, and the hose for damages. Use long matches. Electric barbecue: protect the electricity from water and secure the power cord (Tripping). Completely unroll the power cord.
- Do not leave the barbecue unattended
- Hot coals should not be emptied in the trashcans
- At the end cleanup the waste neatly
- Instruct your ERT-members
- Weather conditions can overrule the permission (strong wind, code orange/red)
- All damage caused by the barbecue activity is borne by the organizer
- Consider other campus residents
- In case of doubt or questions call security (040 2305 441)
- Security can revoke the permission as they see fit.
